This dynamic course will provide the participants the opportunity for hands on scientific based fire death investigations utilizing cadavers in partnership with Applied Anatomical Research Center- SHSU. Instruction will follow **NFPA 921: Guide for Fire and Explosion Investigations** and **NFPA 1033: Standard for Professional Qualifications for Fire Investigators** systematic processes for crime scene management from the initial scene approach through data collection, evidence collection, documentation and criminal scene processing.


